

Rocklin Academy History

- Rocklin Academy is a public, tuition free charter school
- Rocklin parents and educators started planning in 1998
- Development of the school was led by Dr. Patterson, parents and educators
- School opened in 2001, charter renewed in 2005, 2010, 2015
- Second school opened in 2007 at Meyers campus
- Historically one of the highest performing school in the greater
 Sacramento area
- Awarded California Distinguished School by Department of Education in 2010
- Rocklin Academy Faculty won Learning Forward's Shirley Hord Team Learning Award in 2010
- 2016 and 2017 Voted by Niche as #1 and #2 best charter schools in the Greater Sacramento Area
