Program Details

- Students will be enrolled in the program for the 2020-2021 school-year. If students request to disenroll from the program and request to enroll in on-site instruction, they may return to on-site instruction if space is available.
- Students will return to their site-based school for the 2021-2022 school-year.
- Students will attend their regularly scheduled classes via Live Learning on Zoom.
- Students may participate in extracurricular activities.

RAFOS Staff Commitments

- Rocklin Academy staff will provide quality instruction virtually during normal school hours from their assigned teacher(s).
- Rocklin Academy staff will continue to connect families with site-based school via school newsletters and communication.
- Rocklin Academy staff will provide report cards following the normal trimester school calendar.

Parent Commitments

- Students require high-speed internet access. If this is not available at home, it is the parent's responsibility to work with the school to find available resources.
- Parent's will ensure their child(ren) are able to successfully login and participate appropriately during Zoom class time.
- Parents will ensure submission of all completed assignments and assessments.
- Parents are liable for the cost of replacement or repair for any damaged or destroyed instructional material, electronic device, or other school property checked out to the student.

Student Commitments

- Daily attendance is required and will be monitored. Absences must be reported.
- Students will follow the rules and standards of discipline expected in the classroom and as outlined in the Parent/Student Handbook and RAFOS Board policies.
- Students will log onto Zoom with video, muted, and participate in class activities including group work via breakout rooms.
- Students will ask for help when needed.
